Supervisor Responsibilities

Recruit, train and supervise volunteer family coaches

Essential Functions

Complete intake calls to check for suitability to assist through SFFC AK

Make referrals to other assisting local organizations if SFFC AK cannot assist caller

Match placing child with host family

Complete Host Family Home Evaluation

Train Host Families, Family Coaches, and Ministry Leads

Oversee placements, volunteers, and family coaches

Regularly give compelling presentations to diverse local church audiences about the work of Safe Families

Network within the community to build alliances and open avenues for the recruitment of volunteers
